FINE FINISH

DESCRIPTION

Bostik Fine Finish is a ready to use surface finish suitable for covering slight imperfections in timber, plaster, mortar, concrete and primed metal, providing a hard and smooth finish. It has been specially designed for use as a surface finish under gloss paint.

PREPARATION

Surfaces should be clean and dry with no loose or powdery material or paint. If applying over gloss paint, use Bostik Degloss to improve adhesion.

PRECAUTION

Not suitable for outdoor use, or filling large holes – use Bostik Heavy Filler instead. Use Bostik Fill-A-Gap sealant where movement occurs

APPLICATION

- Knead tube before use to ensure an even consistency.
- Squeeze a small amount of filler onto a flexible filling blade.
- Apply in thin coats (1-2mm) to avoid cracking, pressing firmly into the area being filled. Remove any excess filler.
- Allow each layer to dry before applying next layer.
- Dries in 2-3 hours in thin applications depending on atmospheric conditions.
- When dry, use 180-240 grit sandpaper if a smoother surface if required.
- It is not necessary to prime over Bostik Fine Finish before painting.
- Bostik Fine Finish can be painted with water or oil based paints.
