DESCRIPTION

Bostik KwikSet light weight filler is a ready to use repair paste, suitable for filling interior cracks, chips and holes in plaster, plasterboard, wallboard and wood.

RECOMMENDED USES

- Use on mortar, concrete, timber, plaster, and primed metal.
- Suitable for repairs to plaster and plasterboard.

FEATURES AND BENEFITS

- Paintable in 30 minutes
- · Ready to use
- · Applicator included

APPLICATION

- Surfaces should be clean and dry with no loose or powdery material or paint.
- Prime any exposed nail heads prior to use
- Using applicator provided, apply KwikSet to required area pressing firmly into hole/crack.
- Smooth off area and allow to dry for 30 minutes in thin areas, allow a longer time period for deeper holes/cracks and on non – porous surfaces
- KwikSet can be sanded and painted when dry (allow 24 hours drying time before using an oil based paint.

CLEANING

Clean tools and hands with soapy water while still wet.

PRECAUTION

- Not suitable for outdoor use
- · Use flexible filler where joint movement occurs
