WHAT IS SECURARAIN™ ALL ABOUT?

Secura*Rain*[™] is a piping system for a home's supplementary rainwater installation.

DO I NEED A DIFFERENT PIPE FOR A RAINWATER SYSTEM?

Yes. If your home is supplied from the council water main and you wish to connect a supplementary supply from a rainwater storage tank or bore to your home's plumbing system then that pipe system and outlets must be clearly identified as 'Rainwater'.

ARE THERE ANY SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR INSTALLATION?

Yes. Installation must avoid cross contamination so special requirements are detailed in AS/NZS 3500.1.2003

WHAT SIZES ARE AVAILABLE?

Secura*Rain*[™] piping is now available in 15mm and 20mm sizes with a pressure rating of 1600kPa to cater specifically for these installations.

WHAT FITTINGS CAN I USE?

Secura*Rain*[™] pipe is manufactured according to AS/NZS 2642.2 requirements and can utilise the full range of solid brass SecuraGold fittings with absolute confidence.

HOW WILL A RAINWATER STORAGE SYSTEM HELP ME?

- It will reduce your bills if your current water supply is metered.
- It can reduce reliance on the town mains supply and reduce inconvenience during water restrictions.
- It will help preserve a valuable asset.

Local authorities are encouraging the installation of suburban rainwater storage systems for watering the garden and washing cars to help reduce the wasteful demand on town mains supplies.

These urban rainwater systems when connected to a home's plumbing system can either replace or supplement the town mains supply reducing costs and inconvenience of not having water during times of shortage.

WHAT IS SECURALILAC™ ALL ABOUT?

Secura*Lilac*[™] is a piping system for recycled water supplies.

SO WHY WOULD I WANT A NON-**POTABLE (UNDRINKABLE) WATER SUPPLY?**

To save money and dramatically reduce water wastage.

Secura*Lilac*[™] is designed to be part of a growing need for households to reduce their water wastage.

Both important if you're on a limited rainwater tank supply or connected to a metered town mains.

WHAT IS RECYCLED WATER?

Typically it is water collected from the washing machine and bathroom wastes and recycled to use in the garden, wash the house, wash the car and flush the

It can be treated grey water from washing machine and bathroom wastes or rainwater storage tanks.

HOW CAN I INSTALL A NON-POTABLE WATER SYSTEM?

There are special conditions detailed in AS/NZS 3500.1.2003. A plumber needs to install a 'split plumbing system' to keep the home's potable water supplies completely separate.

A split system is comprised of:

- 1. One separate pipeline for potable (drinkable) water from the mains or a filtered rainwater supply to the hot and cold taps.
- 2. Another totally separate *Lilac* coloured pipeline for the recycled water system piped to the toilets and the outside taps for watering the garden, washing the car and the

WHY THE COLOUR LILAC. CAN'T I USE **SOMETHING ELSE?**
